- There is no Daily Mass while Father Arpee is away. Daily Mass will resume Wednesday March 20, 2024 at 8:30 a.m.

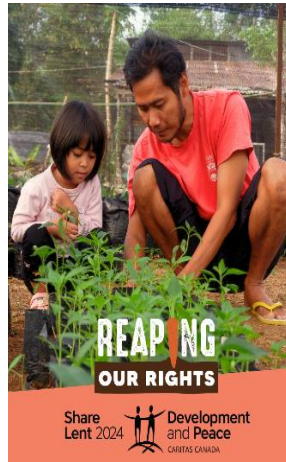
### Calla Lilly Sale

#### Training next-generation farmers in Indonesia



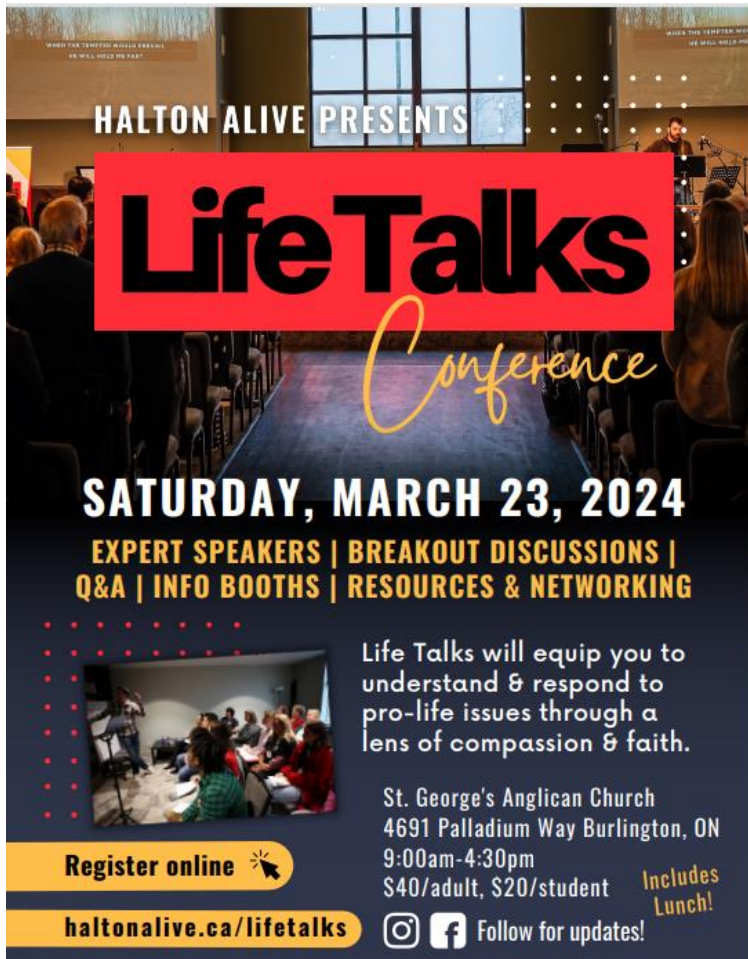
In rural Indonesia, young people are abandoning agriculture to work in cities. Over time, this could threaten food sovereignty.
